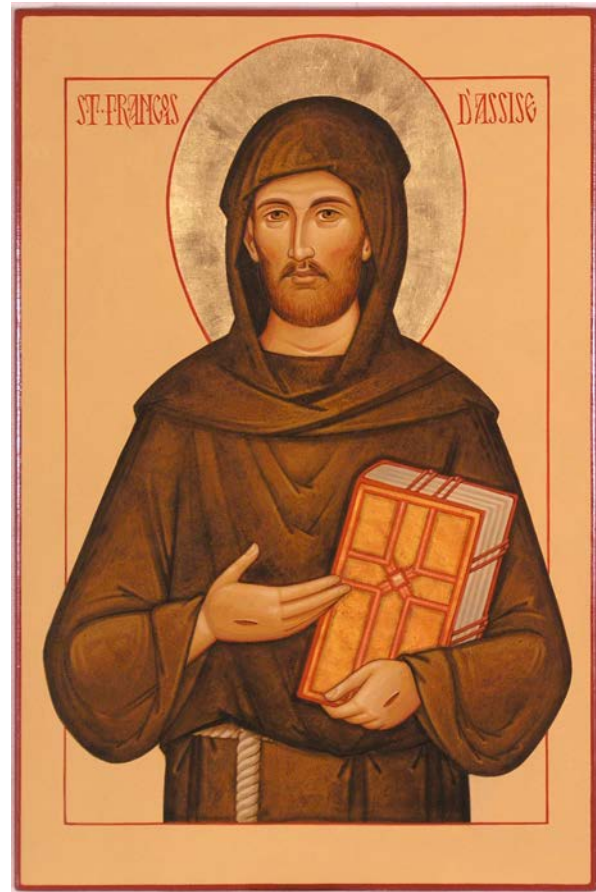

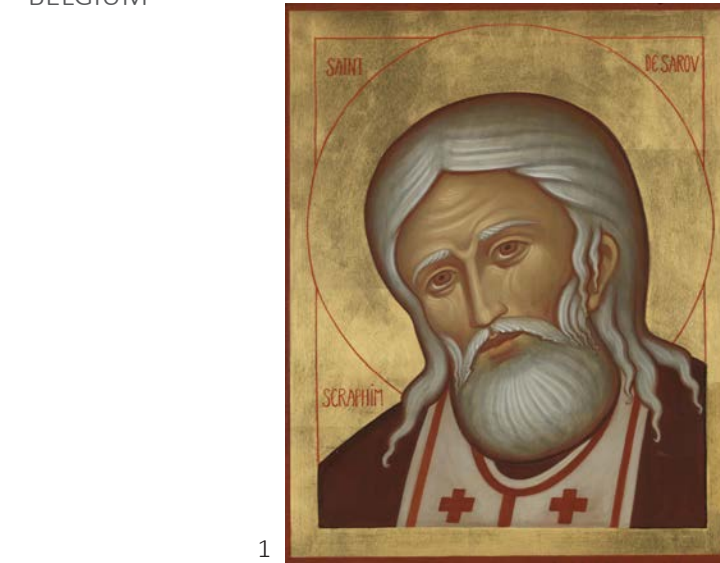


1. St. John the Baptist and St. Andrew; Brussels, Parish Church of Saint-Gilles, 2013
